Summer Academy Classes

C.A.T.C.H Summer Fun

C.A.T.C.H (Centered Approach to Child Health) – For existing kindergarteners going into first grade. Join us for summer fun activities to include: Growing food in the green house, music & movement, arts & crafts, recreation, and literacy games. Help your kindergartener keep learning to avoid losing information over the summer. We will meet **T/Th starting July 9th through August 1st 9am – 12 pm**. Lunch will be served and transportation is available.

Jump Start to KG

Jump Start is for incoming kindergarteners that will be attending River Mill in the Fall. Class focusses on kindergarten readiness skills, get to know the school and staff before school starts to help with an easier transition to school, meet new friends and learn literacy skills. You get a free book and bag of goodies for attending. **This is a two-week class, August 5th through 16th, M-F, 8:30 am – 12:30 pm**. Breakfast and lunch is included and transportation is available. – Class size will be limited so register early.

Literacy Lift-Off!

Literacy Lift-Off is reading intervention class for existing 1st graders going into 2nd grade in the fall. Class will focus on foundational skills of reading such as letter sounds, blending, and learning sight words. Phonological awareness skills, reading text, and playing fun games will help your 1st graders become better readers before they move up to 2nd grade. **This is a two-week class, August 5th through 16th, M-F, 8:30am – 12:30 pm**. Breakfast and lunch is included and transportation is available.
